

## Placement/Traineeship Position - Volda University College (Norway)

Department	International Office – Pangaia, international meeting place on campus
Duration	11 months
Starting/End dates	1 <sup>st</sup> August 2023 to 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2024
Working hours	Main working place is Pangaia, VUC campus. The office is open from 10:30-15:30 Mon-Fri, and sometimes during afternoon. In addition, we expect availability for some weekend activities, such as trips, social events, movie events, Christmas/Easter workshops, Halloween event, national day parade etc.
Privileges	The Pangaia-trainee will be granted free participation in excursions and events coordinated by the International Office and free use of facilities on campus.
Payment	Applicants should preferably receive Erasmus+ Placement grant from the home university.  For non-student applicants, the traineeship grant paid by VUC will be 12000,-kr/month, before tax deduction.
Accommodation	International Office can assist in finding private accommodation, but the trainees can also apply for housing in the student residences.
